THE LIFE & LEGACY OF **Bishop** KERVY BROWN

A TIME TO BE BORN

Bishop Kervy Brown, D.D. was born on May 21, 1959, in the Bronx, New York, to the late Mary Brown and Kervy Brown Sr. in which he was the youngest male child out of 7 children. He was born and raised in New York City's Housing Authority and received his education in the New York Public School System. From a child, he displayed the charisma of being caring, creative, loving, talented and simply just a joy to be around.

A TIME TO BE CALLED TO MINISTRY

Bishop Brown felt a calling to ministry from the young age of 6. He would often sing on the street corners of the Bronx, New York and compel others to come to Christ. As a child, Bishop Brown would sing and preach to local drug dealers in the stairways of his apartment building, and also stand on top of community checkerboard tables outside of his apartment building to minister to local basketball players within the Bronx community. Bishop Brown was highly effective and influential in leading others to Christ within the community.

His mother, the late Mother Mary Brown, was his greatest inspiration. As a gospel group member herself, his mother would often encourage and push him to sing solos in church by coaching and guiding him to open his eyes and boldly walk the church aisles and minister to the church congregation. Bishop Brown would also assist his mother with visiting the local sick and shut-in residents within the community on Saturdays for weekly 12pm prayer. Mother Mary Brown would always require that his baby sister (Robin) attend the weekly prayers with Bishop Brown as well.

A TIME TO SERVE

As an ordained man of God, Bishop Brown had been preaching the gospel since the age of 13. Bishop Brown knew what it meant to struggle; however, he believed what God told his mother concerning him blessing her seeds.

After accepting Jesus Christ as his personal Lord and savior, repenting of his sins and being baptized in Jesus name according to Acts 2:38, he received the gift of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in tongues under his mentor, the late Bishop James Hicks of the New Bethel Way of the Cross Church of Christ. Bishop Brown studied at the Manhattan Bible Institute while gaining his spiritual foundation from his Pastor. While serving in leadership, Bishop Brown's gift of singing was developed, and he became a member of the Bronx Mass Choir under the leadership of Bishop Eric McDaniel and Pastor Roger Hambrick.

He later became a member of the multi-Grammy award winning Love Fellowship Crusade Choir under the direction of then Hezekiah Walker. He traveled the world with the choir and became internationally known from singing the hit song "Spirit Touch Me One More Time" ... While traveling and experiencing a great move of God, the Lord led him to become a member of the Love Fellowship Tabernacle under the leadership of Bishop Hezekiah Walker. He served faithfully as the church Ruling Elder, the director of the Rhema choir and the national and international soloist and revivalists. He was one of the founding members of the Love Fellowship Tabernacle Mass Choir. It was this choir that recorded the hit song "Lord Do It" where Bishop Kervy Brown was the featured lead soloist and immediately the song hit the gospel charts.





In 2006, the New York native moved to Dallas, Texas and served under the divine leadership of Apostle Herman Murray, Pastor of the Full Gospel Holy Temple Church, Inc. Bishop Kervy Brown spent several years serving as their "House Psalmist". While serving under Apostle Murray, Bishop Kervy Brown recorded his 1st LIVE solo album in 2009.

His love for music and prayer was unmeasurable. The highlight of his year was traveling to Chicago, Illinois every Labor Day weekend for 18 consecutive years to attend and serve as the Psalmist, Prayer Leader, and Conference Coordinator for the Angie Ray Ministries International Intercessory Prayer Conference.

A TIME TO PASTOR

After praying and fasting, Bishop Kervy Brown, D.D. was given a new assignment that changed his life forever. Bishop Brown received a phone call from the Late Mother Mary Ann Jackson asking if he would accept the assignment of pastoring Greater Deliverance Temple after the transition of her late husband Bishop Roger L. Jackson. In September of 2009, Bishop Dr. Kervy Brown humbly accepted the call to pastor Greater Deliverance Temple and vowed to God that he would take the church to the next level. Bishop Brown served as the senior pastor of Greater Deliverance Temple for 15 years, where his leadership and vision transformed the congregation into a beacon of hope and love within the community. His dedication to spreading the gospel and fostering a welcoming church family will be remembered by all who knew him. Bishop Brown's legacy will be bestowed upon the members of Greater Deliverance Temple and his special love for his GDT Family will forever be cherished and felt by Greater Deliverance Temple.

In 2024, Bishop Dr. Kervy Brown founded a church network called, "Flaming Fire Alliance". His alliance comprised of 5 local ministries that joined together under his leadership to congregate throughout the year. Bishop Aaron Tharrington, Bishop Irene Cobbs, and Pastor Patrick Keene, and all served under the leadership of Bishop Kervy Brown.

A TIME TO RECEIVE HONOR & RECOGNITION

In 2018, Bishop Brown was appointed and consecrated as a Bishop in the Pentecostal Churches of Jesus Christ now known as Covenant Keepers International Alliance by the Presiding Bishop, Bishop Hezekiah Walker. Bishop Kervy Brown served as the Prelate over the Southern jurisdiction within the Alliance which covers churches in Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia.

In addition to his local pastoral duties, Bishop Brown was actively involved in numerous charitable organizations, advocating for the homeless, and supporting local missions. His generosity and kindness knew no bounds, and he was always willing to extend a helping hand to those in need. Due to Bishop Brown being such a dedicated and passionate minstrel of the gospel, he received an Honorary Doctorate Degree of Divinity, conferred by Dr. Josette Rey from Mount Olive Bible Institute & Seminary in 2023.

In 2023, Bishop Brown was honored by the Gospel Choice Music Awards for his musical contributions and talents within the gospel industry. The Gospel Choice Music Awards awarded Bishop Brown with a Lifetime Achievement Award and Male Artist of the Year award for the song titled, "Our God Reigns" under the leadership of Jeffery Holmes.

A TIME TO MOURN

On, July 7th, 2024, the world lost a dedicated soldier in the kingdom. We lost a giant that will forever be missed, but he is not alone! He will join his beloved parents and 4 older siblings along with his beloved mentors such as Bishop Kenneth Moales Sr, Bishop James H. Hicks, Bishop William L. Bonner and his dear friend Bishop Preston Toogood.

He leaves to mourn and cherish his memories his sisters Robin Brown (Wayne Brown), Loretta Robinson, brother Louis Brown, his cousin Bishop Hezekiah Walker, Carolyn Slade (special spiritual sister), Jackie Groover (special friend) and a host of nieces and nephews, cousins, Godparents and Godchildren. He was affectionately known as "Pop-Pop" by his little princess-Olivia Robinson (granddaughter). Bishop Kervy Brown had a multitude of sons and daughters that he absolutely adored. Lastly, he leaves to mourn and cherish his memory The Greater Deliverance Temple, the church that loved and honored him and allowed Bishop Brown to guide them to the next level as a spiritual father. His dearest and closest friends Dr. Francis Hamilton, Dr. Ron Bigelow, Professor Eric Waddell, Elder Christopher Hairston, Elder Tercel Walker, Bishop Albert Jamison, Delois Snowden, Dianne Simpson, Archbishop Eric Figueroa and Lady Doreen Figueroa, Bishop Alvin Crone, Bishop Kevin Bond and many others. Bishop had the gift to make everyone feel appreciated, blessed and welcomed in his presence. He will never be forgotten.
