## ***“We miss you Hiroshi”***

Hiroshi Fujimoto passed away peacefully on February 28, 2014 following a courageous battle with cancer.

He was born March 31, 1949 to Yasushi and Toshiko Fujimoto in Tokyo, Japan. At the age of 14 Hiroshi immigrated to San Diego to live with his aunt, Sue Harper and her family. In 1967, he graduated from Hollywood High School and went on to CSU Los Angeles where he was an outstanding gymnast.

In the early 1970s he came to Monterey and was hired by Dr. Gordon Schacher to teach and coach the Monterey Peninsula Gymnastics Club. In 1976 he founded the Monterey Gymnastics Center on Dela Vina Avenue in Monterey with Dr. Schacher, Rick Johnson and Gloria Elber. In the ensuing years, the Center became a dynamic force in the gymnastics world, teaching thousands of Monterey Peninsula young people, and coaching competitive gymnasts to local, state, regional and national championship levels. Hiroshi taught gymnastics classes at the Center and at Monterey Peninsula College, where his evening classes attracted beginning, and intermediate level students, many of whom went on to train and compete at the Center. Years later many of these early students returned to Monterey Peninsula Gymnastics Center to have their own children and grandchildren be coached by Hiroshi.

Hiroshi also was a force in the world of gymnastics competition throughout the Western United States. He was State Chair of the Northern California Boys Gymnastics Association and USA Gymnastics Region 1 Chairman. His expertise in coaching and distinctive quiet and calm demeanor were well recognized throughout the sport. Over the years, Monterey Gymnastics Center was a favorite spot for both national and international level gymnasts and Olympic athletes to visit and workout with Hiroshi.

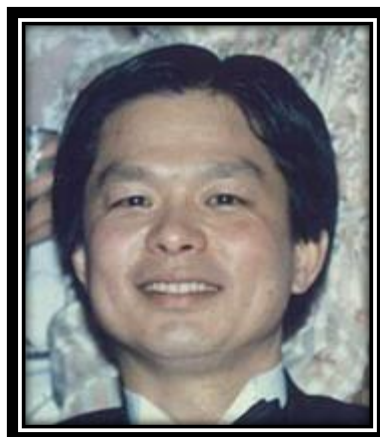
After over 30 years at the Monterey location, Hiroshi moved the Center to its present location in Sand City. Along with Head Coach and Program Director, Jessica Rodriguez, the new center grew and continued its long legacy of excellence and commitment to Monterey Peninsula youth. It is now the oldest privately owned gymnastics center in the United States.

Hiroshi is survived by his parents, Yasushi and Toshiko Fujimoto; his sister, Yuki (Ararata) Kamochi; nephew, Ken and niece, Lisa, all of Tokyo; his beloved aunt, Sue Ruddy (Jim) of Palm Springs and his cousins (far more like brothers), Michael (Daria) Harper of Valencia and their children, Shane and Christen; Mark Harper (Chieko) and children, Erika, Ellena and Emma of Denver, Colorado; Scott Harper of Los Angeles; his longtime friends, Rick and Chris Johnson and their sons, Tyler and Oliver of Monterey; and Jessica Rodriguez and Edgar Marin and their young son, Maddox, who called him "Papa."

Hiroshi is also survived by the many gymnasts and their families, whose lives were forever changed by his goodness, quiet strength and commitment to others.

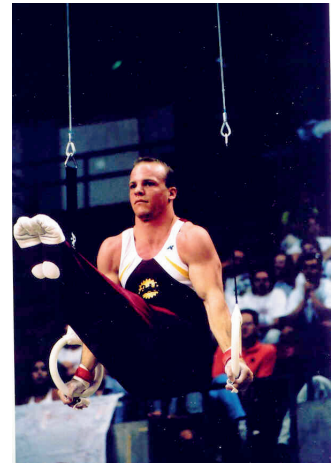

# Hiroshi Fujimoto Recognition Award

This award is handed out each year at the Men's Region 1 Championships. The recipient of the award is a person in the Region who has given of himself/herself above and beyond other members of Region 1. This award is in recognition of selflessness of the recipient in either the prior year, or in a cumulative basis throughout many years. This award is the most prestigious award given to a member of our Region 1 gymnastics community. It reflects the dedication of that years' recipient to the development, administration, vision and/or quality of men's gymnastics in Region 1 in the spirit of Hiroshi Fujimoto's contribution to our region.

Recognition Award is presented to:

**Rob Survick**



Rob's lifelong commitment to men's gymnastics reflects the very spirit of the Hiroshi Fujimoto Award. A member of the Arizona State University men's gymnastics team beginning in 1998, Rob competed with passion while also becoming a strong advocate for the survival and growth of the program during a challenging era for collegiate men's gymnastics. The opportunity to compete, travel, and be part of a team performing high-level gymnastics left a lasting impression on him and shaped the dedication he carried into a lifetime of service to the sport.

Following his collegiate career, Rob became a respected and influential coach within the Region One community. From his early coaching roles at Sunday's Gymnastics and Desert Devils under Chris Sommer, to joining the Aspire and Junior Sun Devils staff in 2005 under Dan Hayden, Rob demonstrated leadership, humility, and a deep commitment to athlete development. That same year, he helped launch Arizona's TNT program and served as the state's first TNT State Director, building a strong and respected program that expanded opportunities for athletes across the region. When GymACT was established in 2018, Rob played an important role in building and sustaining the program, helping create continued competitive opportunities for athletes. He was recognized as GymACT Assistant Coach of the Year in 2023, and many of his athletes from Arizona went on to participate in the program. In recognition of his broader impact as a coach and mentor, Rob was also named Positive Alliance Region Coach of the Year in 2024.

As Head Coach of the Junior Sun Devils beginning in 2011, Rob made a lasting impact on countless young athletes. Known for his ability to recognize potential and bring out the very best in those around him, Rob used gymnastics as a platform to build confidence, character, and resilience. Many of his athletes advanced to outstanding NCAA programs, including Brandon Briones, whom Rob coached to the 2018 Youth Olympic Games. Rob believed that **life is meant to be lived fully, enjoyed deeply, and shared with the people you love**, and that spirit was reflected in the passion, generosity, and dedication he brought to the athletes, teams, and community he served.

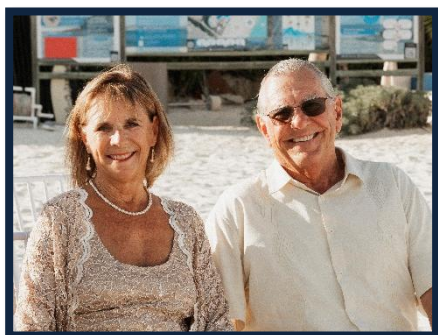

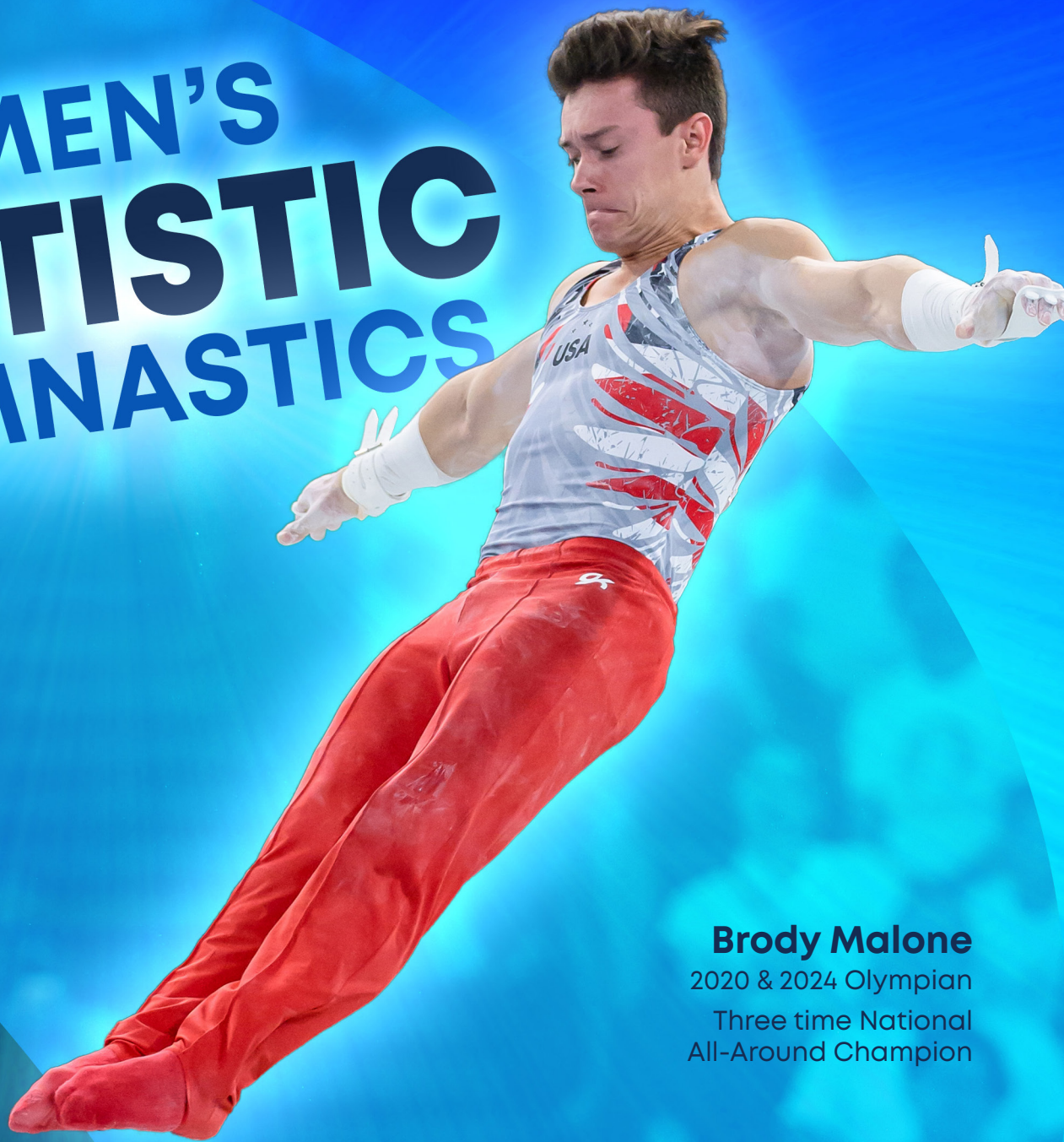

# MEN'S ARTISTIC GYMNASTICS



## **Brody Malone**

2020 & 2024 Olympian

Three time National  
All-Around Champion

There are six events in men's gymnastics — floor exercise, pommel horse, still rings, vault, parallel bars and horizontal bar. This discipline requires an incredible amount of strength and power. Below is information on each of the six events.

## FLOOR EXERCISE

Floor routines consist of dynamic tumbling skills. The best gymnasts will incorporate tumbling passes with multiple twisting and flipping, both forward and backward, throughout their routine. A gymnast must show power and control on this event.

## POMMEL HORSE

Considered by many to be the most difficult of all men's events, the pommel horse is also the most subtle. Each move is defined by complex hand placements. The gymnast must perform continuous circular movements interrupted only by the required scissors elements. The entire exercise should flow with controlled rhythm. A gymnast must show precise timing and balance throughout the routine.

## STILL RINGS

Of all the men's events, rings are the least stable, therefore requiring the greatest amount of strength. Just as its name suggests, the rings must be kept still while the gymnast is performing. There are two types of moves on the rings — strength positions and swing movements. Those with the best command of the event will display extraordinary skill in arriving at all required "holds" with absolute precision.

## VAULT

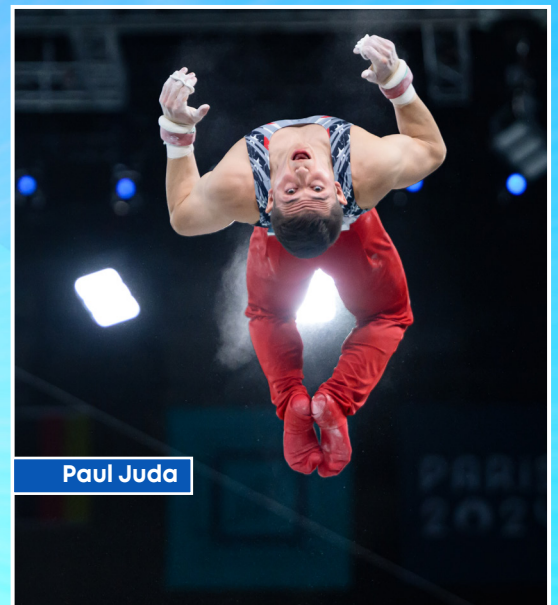
Each vault is categorized in the Code of Points, the official rule book giving the relevant value of each skill performed. A good vault is sometimes described as a "big" vault. The more twists and flips in the "post" flight, the more difficult the vault. The height, the distance of travel, the overall acceleration into the vault and the sudden impact of a no-step, "stuck" landing all create a good impression for the judges.

## PARALLEL BARS

A parallel bar routine consists of predominantly long-hand swing, support and flight elements, which move above and below the bars. Watch for the gymnast to execute swing elements and skills in which both hands release and regrasp the bars. Some gymnasts move outside the two rails, performing press handstands and pirouettes on only one bar.

## HORIZONTAL BAR

This event is also known as the high bar, and routines consist exclusively of swinging parts without stops. The parts are generally called giant swings, with more specific terms applying to changes in grip, direction and body position. Watch for the gymnast to execute release moves. Look for high-flying dismounts with multiple flips and twists and, of course, the gymnast aims to land the dismount with no extra steps.

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# The Benefits and Opportunities of College Club Gymnastics

It takes a special kind of athlete to be a gymnast. It takes an equally dedicated and understanding family to have one of their own in this sport. Most likely you got into this sport because it was a fun activity or your parents put you into it to “burn off energy”. But now.... you are coming to a fork in the road where you will need to decide where and IF you will be doing gymnastics in college. It is most likely one of the biggest decisions you will make up to this point in your life. So here is a little more info to help you in your decision-making process.

I have had the great benefit of coaching for 15 years on the NCAA level (assistant coach at Arizona State University, ‘78- ‘93) and for the past 32 years on the College Club level (ASU since 1993). Let me first say that BOTH systems have their advantages and disadvantages, opportunities, challenges and strengths. There is no doubt about it, that the greatest college meet in the world is our own NCAA championships each and every year. Even though our total number of NCAA teams has dwindled from 176 in the 70’s to only 15 today (with more D3 programs on the horizon!), the quality of the NCAA Championship has continued to get BETTER each year! So if you are intent on being a part of the highest quality and most competitive program, the NCAA is the way to go. But... as you can imagine, there are only a very few spots open on the NCAA level each year for junior gymnasts to step into. SO ... if you aren’t offered a scholarship or even a walk-on position, what are your options?

This is where the Gymnastics Association of College Teams (GymACT) comes in. There are over 2 million college students engaged in a variety of club sports across the country each year, and that number continues to grow. As does the number of college club gymnasts.

## Why is this?

Right now there are a handful of college clubs that are dedicated to excellence in training. I have been asked many times what the main differences are between GymACT and NCAA teams. My answer to them is, “we are basically the same except for TWO things.... 1) we are not funded by the school and 2) we cannot compete at the NCAA championships.” Now admittedly, not being supported financially by the university has many other ramifications such as: No (or very limited) scholarships, access to medical facilities & supplies and academic support. So why even consider being a part of a college club team?

## Because of the **OPPORTUNITIES!**

I will always encourage anyone that if they are serious and passionate about this sport and they can get a scholarship to a school they like... TAKE IT! It is the best opportunity around. But if you can’t, THERE ARE SOME GREAT, and GROWING number of OPPORTUNITIES within the GymACT Team programs to enable you to reach your academic goals and pursue your passion of continuing to grow as a gymnast. Remember, guys begin to reach their full gymnastics maturity most of the time between 18 and 24 years of age. So if you didn’t win the JO Nationals title as a senior in high school, you still have a long way to go in pursuing your dreams!

I believe Club Gymnastics offers the following 2 great benefits:

- *Keeping Dreams Alive &*
- *Providing Opportunities*

Being a part of a collegiate gymnastics program (whether NCAA or GymACT) provides opportunities for junior gymnasts to continue the sport they love while pursuing an education for life. Here are 7 benefits you can expect to get out of being a part of a college team:

1. College education- This is what opens doors for you to the future
2. Continuing in gymnastics- The college years for male gymnasts are when men mature and really benefit from all the basic training they invested to this point. (I.e.- strength, skills & experience all come together). Develop your potential!
3. Friendships- and lifelong relationships are forged.
4. Regular Season Competitions- between other Collegiate and NCAA teams.
5. National individual and team championship competition.
6. Individual Growth.
7. Being a part of a team of guys all pursuing the same common goals- This is probably the greatest benefit you can realize as a collegiate gymnast. Scholarship or not, get into the right program for your ability and this is yours!

As I have observed over the last 32 years, there has developed a 3-tiered college system of teams that has taken root:

- **NCAA Teams**: Generally funded by the university. Most offer scholarships, medical and academic support. Needless to say, that with a maximum of only 6.3 scholarships that can be offered per school, the odds are not very good in getting a scholarship unless you are one of the top juniors in the country. There are currently 15 NCAA teams.
- **GymACT Teams**: Those club teams that have demonstrated a desire to compete on a level that can “hang” with many other NCAA teams. Generally non-funded by the school and have to raise all their own operating expenses (training, competition, coaching, etc.) through fund-raising and booster clubs. Most of these teams have a dedicated coaching staff. The year-end Championship for this tier is the GymACT Nationals Team Championships on Saturday night of the USAG JD Nationals- this year in Oklahoma City, OK. No limit as to the number of participants and each school sets their own participation criteria. (In order to be on the Arizona team one must agree to 1) be at practice as agreed upon, 2) help with fund-raising events & 3) be dedicated to the basic team training principles). Currently 16 teams.
- **NAIGC Teams**: Similar to GymACT teams but mostly student led and coached. The main Championships for these teams are the NAIGC Men’s & Women’s Nationals- A rapidly growing yearly championship meet. Approximately 60+ teams. [www.NAIGC.org](http://www.NAIGC.org)

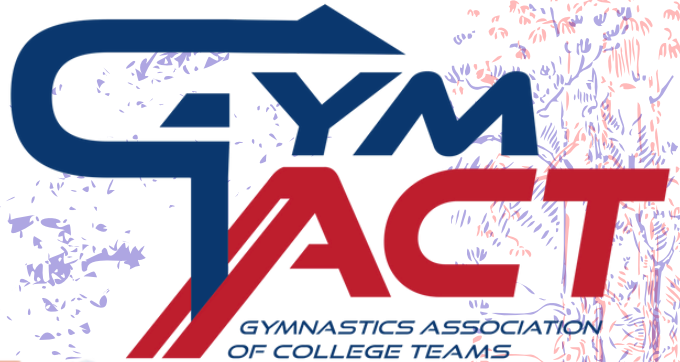
